The positions are available at all levels: Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Full Professor, depending on qualifications and experience. We seek unique and committed colleagues who will positively contribute to the teaching, research, and service efforts of the School. The candidate should have demonstrated excellence in original research for advancing knowledge in one or more core areas.

Faculty responsibilities include teaching at the graduate and undergraduate levels, conducting original and innovative research, student advising, and public services. Applicants should hold a Ph.D. in transportation engineering or a relevant science or engineering field by the beginning of employment.

Research areas of interest include, but are not limited to intelligent transportation systems, traffic safety, transport network optimization, green transport systems, travel behavior analysis, transport economics and policy, advanced pavement materials, transport asset management, etc. We are particularly interested in candidates with a track record involving innovative and collaborative research in advanced technologies and their applications in operation & management of transport systems.

DUT will actively encourage and facilitate qualified candidates to apply for funding and reward opportunities at different levels in the course of their job applications, which offer internationally competitive start-up research fund and a monetary prize. Under the University's special recruitment policies, all successful candidates will be awarded a competitive benefits package (housing allowance, health insurance, children's education, visa application for international applicants, etc.).

An interested applicant should include the following documents in his or her application package:

1. A curriculum vitae, including the following parts, if applicable: Education background, work experience, research interests and experience, teaching interests and experience, list of publications, awards and honors, academic services, etc.; (required)
2. A research statement or plan; (required)

3. At most 5 published or accepted full papers, of which the applicant is the first author or corresponding author; (required)
4. At least 3 referees and their contact information; (required)
5. Recent teaching evaluations; (optional)
6. Other supporting materials. (optional)
