### **CICTP 2016**

The 16th COTA International Conference of Transportation Professionals (CICTP2016) was successfully held during July 6-9, 2016, in Shanghai, China, jointly organized by Chinese Overseas Transportation Association (COTA) and Shanghai Maritime University (SMU). In addition, substantial support was received from various professional organizations internationally, including American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) and the National Natural Science Foundation of China (NSFC), Transportation Research Board (TRB) of the US National Academies.

The conference was chaired by Dr. Youfang Huang, President and Professor of Shanghai Maritime University, Dr. Yafeng Yin, Immediate Former President of COTA and Professor of University of Florida. Dr. Xin Shi, Vice President and Professor of Shanghai Maritime University, Dr. Wei Yan, Vice President and Professor of Shanghai Maritime University, Dr. Yu Zhang, President of COTA and Associate Professor of University of South Florida served as Executive Chairs. 

Other special forums include the Smart-City-Driven Traffic Information Technology and Control Engineering Discipline Development Forum, and Transportation Practitioner Forum.




