

Tsinghua University Selected as CICTP2018 Host

Based on the review results and recommendation from the CICTP2018 Host Selection Committee, the COTA BOD has selected Tsinghua as the host university for CICTP2018.

Tsinghua University was established in 1911. Since China opened up to the world in 1978, Tsinghua University has developed at a breathtaking pace into a comprehensive research university. At present, the university has 14 schools and 56 departments with faculties in science, engineering, humanities, law, medicine, history,



philosophy, economics, management, education and art. The University has now over 25,900 students, including 13,100 undergraduates and 12,800 graduate students. As one of China's most renowned universities, Tsinghua has become an important institution for fostering talent and scientific research.

COTA and Tsinghua University are currently in the contracting process. More information about CICTP2018 will become available later this year.
