Dear NACOTA members and friends:

On behalf of the NACOTA board of directors, I would like to appreciate your support to NACOTA business and wish you a very happy and fruitful Tiger Year!

We had been very busy and productive in the Ox Year. The 13th Annual NACOTA/WCTA Technical Symposium on Sustainable Transportation Development in China was successfully held in Washington DC by NACOTA and Washington D.C. Chinese Transportation Association (WCTA) in January 2010. This symposium attracted many high level speakers, including those from top research institutes in both China and the US and consulting firms.

Another major accomplishment in the Ox Year was the 9th International Conference of Chinese Transportation Professionals (ICCTP 2009) jointly hosted by NACOTA and Harbin Institute of Technology (HIT). A total of 948 papers were received from authors of eight countries and regions, including Mainland China, Taiwan, the United States, Canada, United Kingdom, Germany, Japan, and Korea. To ensure the quality of the ICCTP 2009 proceedings, rigorous technical evaluation and English editing efforts were made. As a result, only about 50% of the submitted papers were accepted for publication. All the papers published in the ICCTP 2009 proceedings have been included in the EI database.

One more thing worth mentioning is that Deans' Forum of Transportation Colleges in China (DFTC) was initiated and launched its first meeting during ICCTP 2009. Deans from more than twenty transportation colleges attended the first forum, in which important issues in transportation engineering and education were identified. It has been decided that DFTC will be an annual event concurrent with ICCTP. We are glad to see that NACOTA's summer conferences be combined with DFTC to discuss important issues for transportation research, education, and engineering practice in China.

These accomplishments in the Ox Year set up a solid foundation for further developments of NACOTA. Thanks to Professor Ping Yi, immediate past president of NACOTA, for his leadership over the past two years. I would also like take the opportunity to thank members of the last NACOTA board for their dedications and hard work. Special thanks to Dr. Yingwu Fang, Dr. Rachel Liu, and Dr. Huaguo Zhou, who completed their terms this January, for their contributions to NACOTA during their tenure. Of course, supports from all NACOTA members and friends are essential for all the accomplishments NACOTA have achieved to date and hence are highly appreciated.

Three new board members have been elected this January. They are Mr. Ken Yang from Iteris, Dr. Zhanping You from Michigan Tech, and Dr. Lei Zhang from University of Maryland. The new board has met twice and been configured in duty assignments as follows:
